### IN MEXICO:



Every day, 10 women are murdered for gender-related reasons. Only 23% of these crimes get a conviction.



Domestic and sexual violence have more than 96% impunity and no accurate data on court rulings.



There are more than 30,000 disappeared women. Between 2019 and 2022, only 141 convictions were issued for this crime.\*

### WHY DO WOMEN HAVE NO ACCESS TO JUSTICE?



The judiciary authorities have the constitutional and conventional obligation to judge with a gender perspective and due diligence in all judicial processes involving women. But, this is not always the case, for the proceedings still have practices that hinder women's access to justice in Mexico, such as:

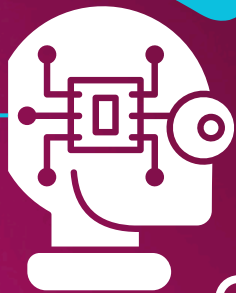
- ✗ Stereotypes
- ✗ Revictimization
- ✗ Delays in the process
- ✗ Unequal treatment
- ✗ Lack of adequate legal counsel
- ✗ Absence of integral reparations
- ✗ Lack of transparent mechanisms for evaluating judges

To demand compliance with the judges' obligations, women need accessible evaluation and information mechanisms which do not yet exist.

**THEREFORE we present an App called Citlali that evaluates the performance of judges to know whether they are fulfilling their duties or not.**



## WHAT IS CITLALI?



### WHY WILL CITLALI TRANSFORM ACCESS TO JUSTICE FOR MEXICAN WOMEN?

CITLALI is an AI agent created to review criminal proceedings and rulings issued by judges in cases of violence against women and girls and to identify the moments in which human rights are violated. It takes into account **8 categories**:

CITLALI's evaluation will measure the performance of criminal justice systems in two categories:

- **Cases:** It will indicate whether the criminal process complied with Human Rights and Gender Perspective parameters.
- **Authorities:** It will evaluate the performance of judges in all cases in which they have participated.

✓ CITLALI will be a powerful tool for users to observe and follow up on the actions of judges, and strengthen social mechanisms of transparency and accountability of the judicial system.

✓ CITLALI's main objective is to transform the judiciary based on informed social demands so that they protect, respect, and guarantee the human rights of women victims of violence.
